

## Suspicious Mail and Delays Communications Toolkit

As an election official, communicating with voters, media, and other community stakeholders is important. This generic, nonpartisan document provides a sample statement to help guide your discussions with key audiences on mail ballots and reported delays. We encourage you to customize the material below based on the particulars of your jurisdiction.

## SAMPLE HOLDING STATEMENT FOR SUSPICIOUS MAIL

## SAMPLE HOLDING STATEMENT FOR MAIL DELAYS

We are aware of reports this week of delays involving election mail in some jurisdictions [add footnote to the reports you are referring to]. Election mail can include voter registration cards, absentee voting applications, polling place location information, and ballots, among other items.

To assist the postal service, we use the Official Election Mail logo to clearly designate communications from this office that should receive expedited handling.
